




## P4G's Market Transformation Approach




### **P4G Business Model**





# Scaling for Market Transformation – SSEZ/SIC Partnership



- P4G investment and support from ecosystem helped SSEZ/SIC Partnership to deliver two industrial parks and become a sustainable business.
- P4G investment in early-stage development of industrial parks helped de-risking work leading to design and achieving financial commitment for construction.
- Development of more zones require risk tolerant capital either supported by government, which is limited, or blended capital.
- Blended capital can potentially unlock development of sustainable economic zones / industrial parks at scale.
- SSEZ/SIC Africa Partnership has provided template to develop investment thesis for blended capital.


